Effective September 1, 2019, Personal Mail will no longer be accepted by the Plymouth County Sheriff's Department at the Plymouth County Correctional Facility.

All Personal Mail must be addressed in the following manner:

Full Name
Address
City, State, Zip code

Inmate / Detaince Name
C/O Securus Digital Mail Center – Plymouth County
PO Box 1071
Lebanon, MO 65536

A return name and address must also be placed on the envelope, failure to properly address the envelope will result in the mail being returned to sender.

Once the mail is received at the Securus Digital Mail Center it will be digitally scanned and printed, then delivered to the inmate / detainee.

Pictures, drawings etc. will be accepted for scanning, printed and delivered in the same manner. Any person sending personal mail that wishes to have it returned to them, must include a self-addressed, stamped envelope included with the original mail.

The facility will continue to accept:

- A. Legal Mail
- **B.** Publications-Directly sent in from a publisher, distributor or authorize retailer (as described in the Inmate Handbook and facility procedure)
- C. Money Orders
